Please see highlighted text below for additional guidance.

This letter is to inform you of a change in reporting requirements for Perinatal HIV Rapid Testing Monthly Reports. Beginning in April 2020, hospitals were required to send their Perinatal HIV Rapid Testing Monthly Reports directly to the Illinois Department of Public Health via the <u>DPH.PerinatalHIV@Illinois.gov</u> email address. As of July 1, 2022, reports are to be sent to Mother and Child Alliance (MACA), previously known as Pediatric AIDS Chicago Prevention Initiative (PACPI) at the following email address <u>Reports@MACA-us.org</u>.

Please send all future, and previous reports dating back to April 2020 if not previously submitted, to MACA. Please do NOT report any further monthly hospital testing information to the Perinatal HIV Reporting System as this system is being retired. All perinatal HIV testing reports should be sent to <u>Reports@Maca-US.org</u>. Staff from MACA may contact you to confirm data received or to resolve reporting issues with data submitted to IDPH between April 2020 and June 2022.
